Essential Components of Digital Citizenship



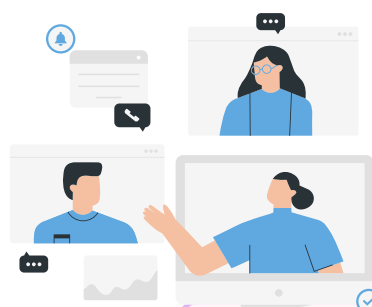
Educate on:
